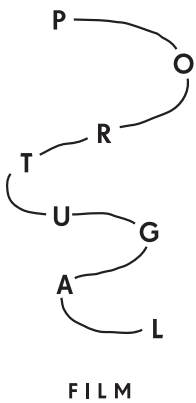

**Short Bio-Filmography:** Jorge Jácome (b. 1988) is a filmmaker, graduated in ESTC, in Lisbon, and in Le Fresnoy - Studio National des Arts Contemporains, in Tourcoing. In his works he investigates relations between utopias, melancholy, disappearance and desire. His films have been shown in several festivals (IndieLisboa, Curtas – Vila do Conde, Premiers Plans d'Angers, Côté Court, EMAF - Osnabrück, BIEFF, among others) and in exhibition contexts in Palais de Tokyo and in La Maison Européenne de la Photographie, Paris. In 2017 he won the "York University Award for Best Student Work on Screen" with "Fiesta Forever" at Images Festival, Toronto and the "New Talent" award with "Flores" at IndieLisboa. In 2015 he won the "Studio Collector" prize with "A GUEST + A HOST = A GHOST". Parallel to his work as a filmmaker he regularly collaborates in performing arts projects.
